## 2013 Auckland Open- Conditions of Entry Please read and take special note of entry and fee payment requirements

### General:

- 1. It is expected that players will have read, and are familiar with the 'Conditions of Entry' prior to submitting an entry
- 2. Any player entering must be a member of, and in good standing with an Association affiliated to Badminton New Zealand or the Badminton World Federation
- 3. The rules of play shall be those of the Badminton World Federation
- 4. The BWF scoring system is to be used.
- 5. All questions as to the rules shall be resolved by an appointed tournament official.
- 6. Tourney No.1 shuttles will be used
- 7. The tournament will be seeded using the most recent Player Points listing available at the time of the draw.
- 8. The draw will be made on Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> September and will be available on the Badminton New Zealand and Auckland Badminton website. The first days schedule will be available by Thursday 26<sup>th</sup> September.
- 9. The tournament committee and or referee reserve the right to :
  - Cancel any event in which less than 8 entries are received, or if time does not permit a full competition to be played
  - Change the scoring of plate event if time constraints require
  - Default a player who is not available at the scheduled time

#### **Player Requirements**

10. Players must obtain permission to leave the hall.

- 11. Players will be defaulted if they are not on court ready to play within two minutes of being called
- 12. Players must wear regulation badminton clothing as per the Badminton New Zealand Approved Clothing regulations
- 13. All players must act as umpires or line judges when requested. Failure to do so may result in the player being defaulted. Please check the websites prior to the session for player/umpires (if needed)
- 14. Players compete at their own risk. No responsibility will be accepted for any injury received during this tournament.
- 15. Following one warning of misconduct, the appointed tournament official shall have the authority to disqualify a player from further play if there is a repeat of misconduct.

#### ENTRY DETAILS

- 16. Entry can only be made online and must be received no later than 11.59pm on Friday 20 September. Online entry can be made through <u>www.auckbad.co.nz</u> and <u>www.badminton.org.nz</u>
- 17. Entries for doubles and mixed doubles will not be accepted unless entries with full payment are received from both partners by the closing time/date. This excludes 'partner required'

entries. It is not the responsibility of Auckland Badminton to follow up entries from nominated, un-entered partners.

- 18. Players withdrawing after entries have closed will not be eligible for refund unless a medical certificate is submitted at the time of withdrawal.
- 19. There will be no replacements is singles events
- 20. Replacements in doubles and mixed doubles events after the draw is published may be allowed only with the approval of the tournament director or referee in line with the BWF competition regulations
- 21. A \$10 administration fee will be deducted from all refunds
- 22. A compulsory BNZ player levy of \$6.00 is payable by all players

NB – Parent name or bank account number does not identify the player – if your system does not allow entry of alpha characters then use your **BNZ player number**. Do not use your date of birth. When entering on-line indicate your payment date.

- 23. Allow at least two working days for payments to be processed through the banking system.
- 24. The entry fee must be in the Auckland Badminton bank account by 5.00pm 25 Sep or the player will be withdrawn from the event, even if the on-line entry was received on-time.
